- ✓ Staff will not be resolving above issues

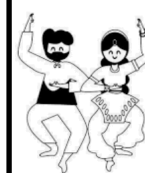
If they become an issue, they will not be allowed again. Students have been briefed on the expectations so they can happily enjoy their cards with others happily.

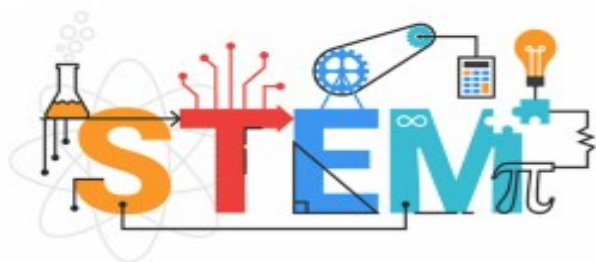

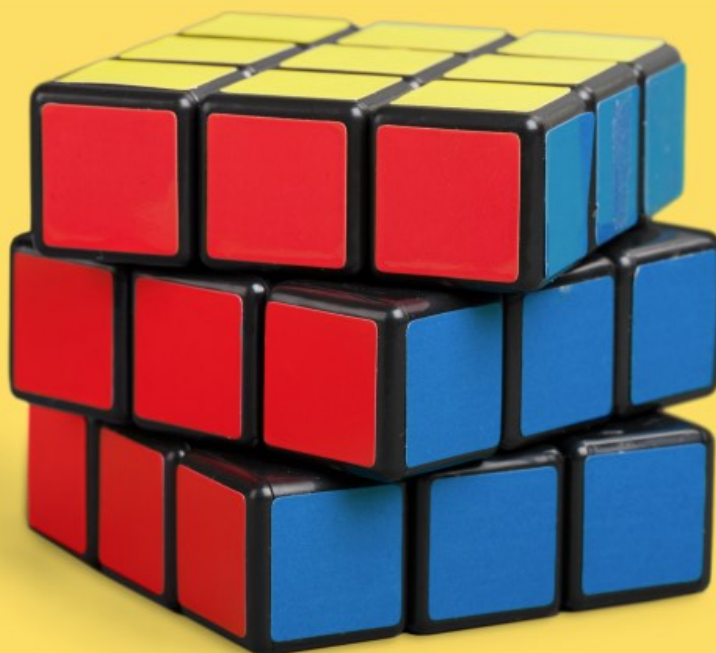
