Starlab Excursion

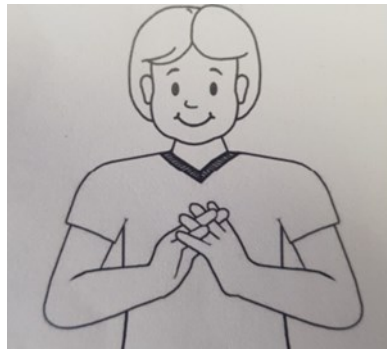

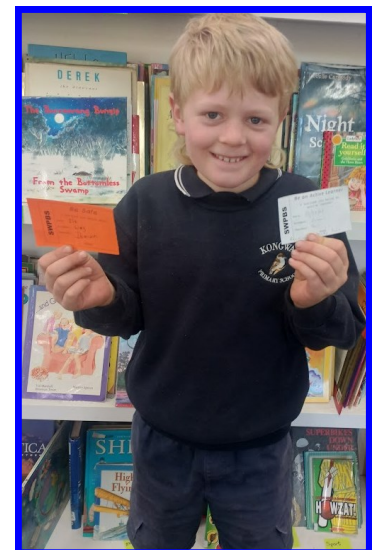
