SWPBS- What Happens When We Make Mistakes?

This week in our SWPBS lesson, we learnt about what happens when we make mistakes in our behaviour. At IKPS, we use a restorative approach to resolving problems and repairing harm. If someone makes a mistake, we expect them to think about what happened, who was affected, how we can make it right, and what we can do to prevent it from happening again. Mistakes are an opportunity for learning!

If there is a problem in the classroom or in the yard, children will be asked to fill in a think sheet to help us (and the child) to understand what has happened and why. This week, every class has practised filling in think sheets using a character from a book. Across the school, every class has been allocated a grade to be their 'support room'. The support room is a place for children to reflect and talk through their think sheet before returning back to their classroom.


ARTIST OF THE WEEK
