- Our **reading** sessions have focused on *fluency when reading* aloud, particularly speed, phrasing, pauses, intonation and stresses. We practised these skills in some short Reader's Theatre plays and performed them for the school on Wednesday.
- In our **writing** sessions, we have begun our Writing Folio Passion Projects by choosing a topic, and are at different stages in planning, drafting, revising and publishing our first pieces, which are persuasive.
- Our **maths** focus has been time, and we have worked hard on reading timetables accurately, converting between minutes, seconds, hours and days, and calculating the time between two events. Our ongoing focus on knowing times tables automatically continues, and everyone is improving so much!

We started our school day at 8am for breakfast in the inlet at Inverloch PS. Our Big Day Out quickly turned into a Big Day In due to the rain. The students and teachers showed great flexibility and resilience as the plans quickly changed. ## SUSTAINABLE KONGWAK


