There are a number of great videos and resources that you can easily implement with your child at home.




We have been focused on what makes a sentence and how to make it interesting.


Over the last three weeks, we have been exploring Number and Place Value. This has included:

- **Everyone**: Reading numbers from 5 digits (tens of thousands) up to 3 decimal places (thousandths) and using < and > symbols to show which is number is bigger.
- **Grade 6:** integers, composite, prime, square and triangular numbers
- Grade 5: placing fractions and decimals on a number line
- Grade 3 and 4: representing decimals in different ways and learning the language of place value

Ask us:

In the number 67, 953. 218

What is the place value of the 6? What is the place value of the 2? What is the place value of the 5?
